### SET Plan (1)



- The SET-Plan adopted in November 2007 is the technology pillar of the <u>EU's energy and climate change</u> <u>policy</u>
- Objective: lower the cost and improve performances of low carbon technologies and accelerate their market uptake to meet the 2020 and 2050 energy policy objectives
- Strategy: a research and innovation and supply chain approach focused on industrial applications; increased cooperation of all stakeholders (industry, research, MS, COM)



## SET Plan – Implementation (1)


- EC: Contribution to R&D and innovation projects through FP7, EERP

- MSs: taking leadership through JPIs and the synchronisation of their calls e.g. 'Berlin model'
- Industry involvement in priority setting and coinvestment







EU contribution per activity (FP7 Energy, 2007-2012; Mio €; share of total)







## Time horizon of FP7 Energy projects (share of EU contribution, 2007-2012)



Geographical origin of participants (FP7 Energy, 2007-2012)



### Where are we?



- Fragmentation Resources continue to be allocated mostly independently
- Leverage of private investments and industrial commitment remains limited
- Lack of coherence of funding e.g. Cohesion funds, Horizon 2020, MSs, ETS etc
- No suitable financing instruments for the SET Plan large scale first-of-a-kind commercial demonstration projects? (breakthrough technologies)
- Integration of research capacities at the very beginning

Prevents reaching a critical mass of public resources and lacks the leverage of significant industrial investments matching the efforts made by Europe's major competitors; Negative effect on visibility and attractiviness of European Actions.


### Energy Roadmap 2050

# MFF 2014 - 2020: an opportunity (1)

- Horizon 2020 key instrument to accompany this transition at EU level:
  - Included as a key challenge 'Secure, clean and efficient energy' under the societal challenges' block of Horizon 2020
  - Access to Risk Financing
  - Separate but complementary programme for nuclear energy activities adopted under the Euratom Treaty
  - Important elements in the other pillars of H2020 (ICT, materials, bio-energy, FET etc)
  - Leveraging industrial participation and MS efforts
- Structural funds to invest in research and innovation and Energy

- Support the implementation of the SET Plan, but how?






## Which Resources?

# Reviewed Energy strategic priorities (1)

 Three first strategic priorities identified, in line with the Energy Policy objectives, to help targeting the EU actions:

### 1. Competitive low carbon energy

- Smart grids and storage
- Low carbon, low cost electricity supply
- Alternative fuels

### 2. Energy efficiency

- Industry
- Buildings
- Market uptake

#### 3. Smart cities

Industry led consortia (energy, ICT and transport).

# Reviewed Energy strategic priorities (2)

- A cross-challenge and cross-pillar approach for the implementation of these actions
- Support the implementation of the SET Plan catalyse a further integration of national research and innovation capacities and Joint actions between MS, including cohesion funds and the EC to leverage significant industrial investments for large research and innovation programmes matching the efforts made by Europe's major competitors.
- **Pilot action for the next 3 years**: launch of a set of Programme Cofund covering several fields (e.g. research on RES and their integration into the grids) at programme level and involving EC and MSs (variable geometry)

### **EERA**



### EERA - a key mechanism for the SET Plan

- Strong mobilisation of Energy Research Organisations:
  - More than 150 participating organisations
  - About 2700 professionals full time equivalent (in kind contribution of roughly ~ 400M €)
- Key principle of Horizon 2020 → Partnering with European stakeholders to share resources and implement jointly:
  - Recognition of the EERA: "Consideration will be given to provide support, including with Member States, to alliances of public research performers, in particular, the EERA established under the SET Plan to pool public research resources and infrastructures to address critical research areas of European interest"
- Next steps: to reinforce the role of the EERA in the emerging Research and Innovation landscape in the field of energy (on-going discussion between EERA/EC/MSs)

### **Summary**



#### **Key messages**

- Long term vision (strategy 20-20-20, Energy Roadmap 2050, etc.)
- Need for an energy mix encompassing a wide range of low carbon energy technologies
- Importance of research at EU level (new technologies, system integration, large-scale demos)
- Importance of an efficient organisation at EU level = Horizon 2020 an opportunity (SET Plan, partnerships, international cooperation)
